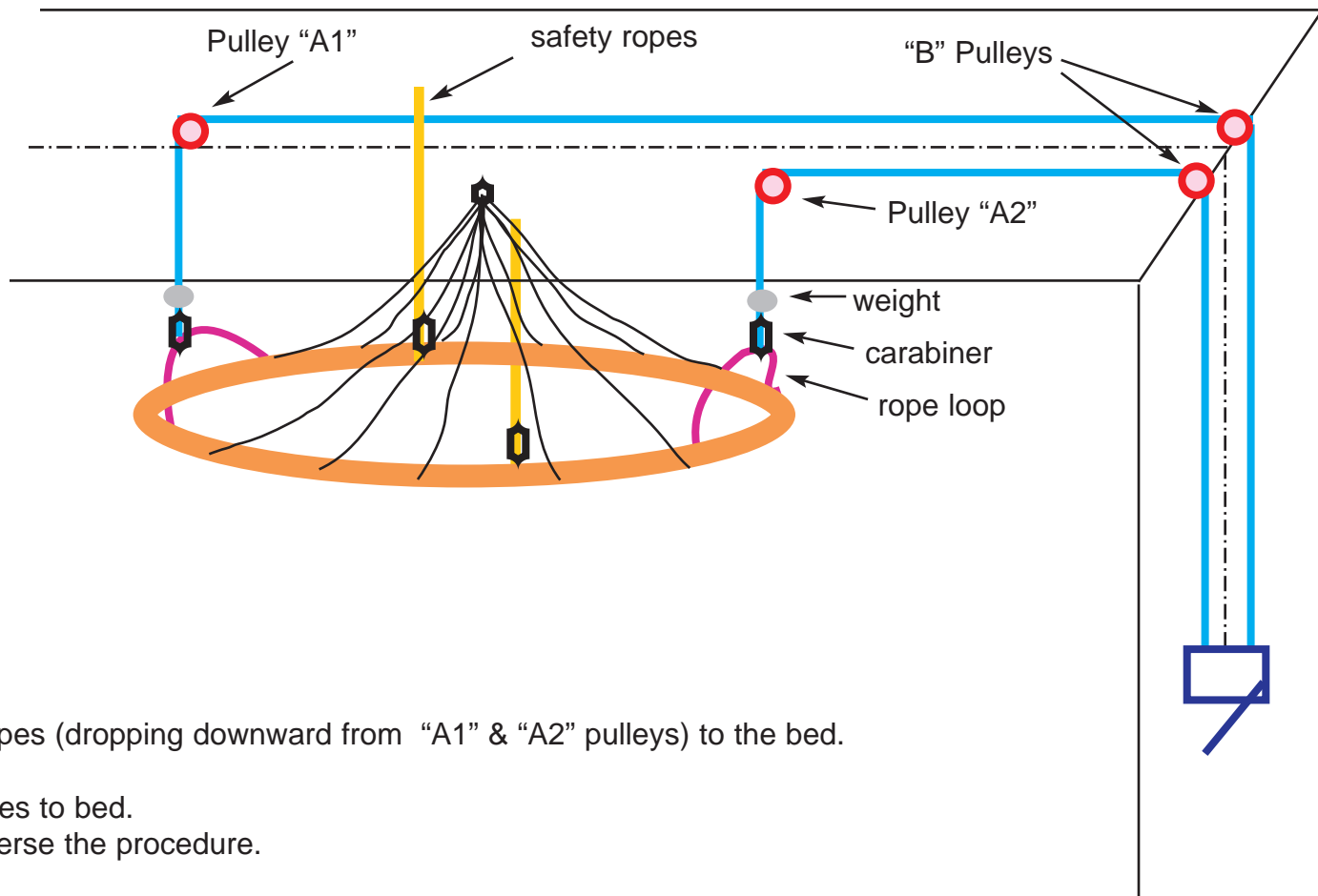


Hanging Bed Hoist



Hoist

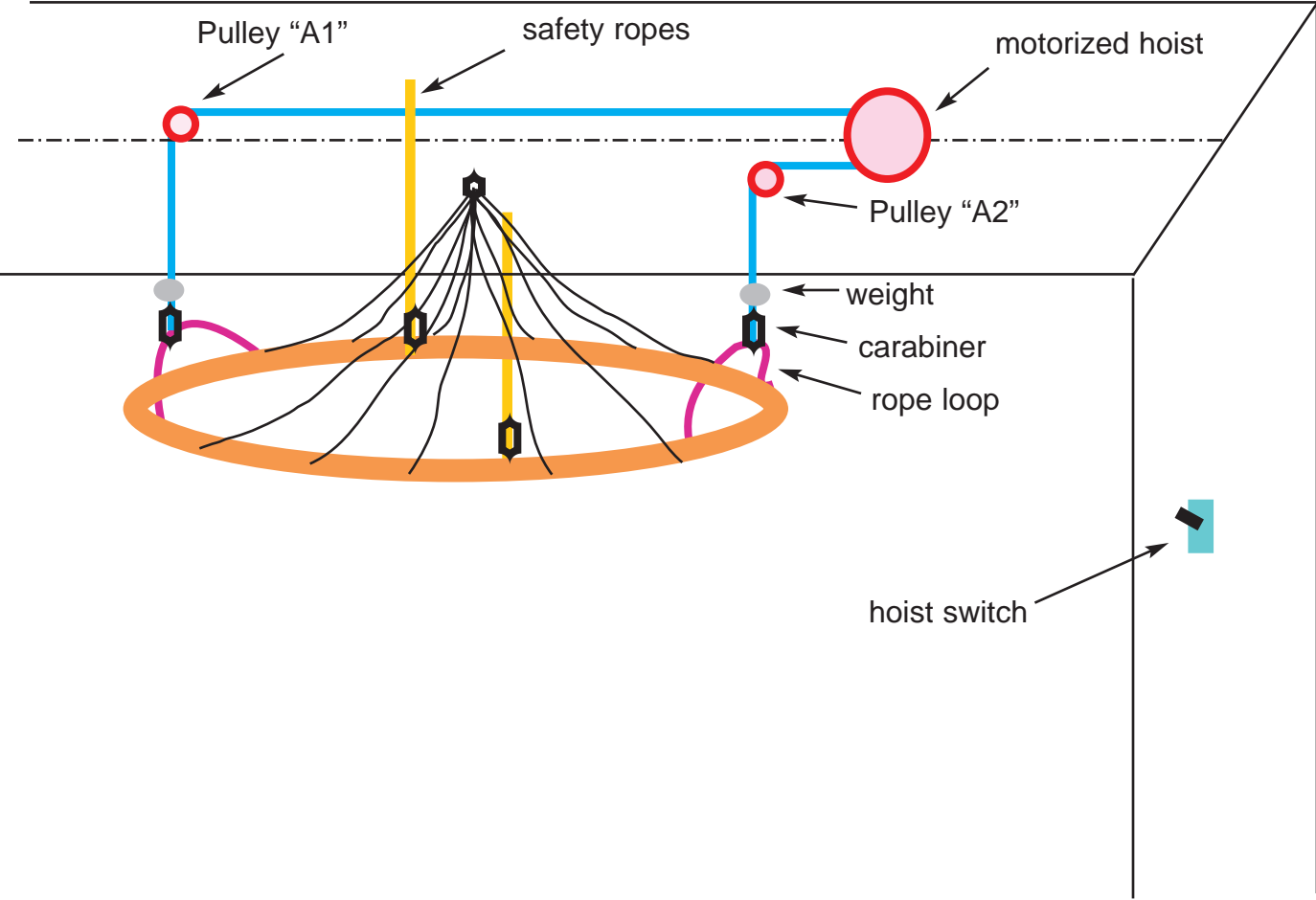
- User attaches vertical ropes (dropping downward from "A1" & "A2" pulleys) to the bed.
- User raises hoist.
- User attaches safety ropes to bed.
- To lower bed, simply reverse the procedure.

The pulleys and much of the rope can be hidden in the attic or joist space, especially with electric hoist.

Sliding /Moving Bracket (or add-a-beam)

- Added beam is attached to side walls, slightly below ceiling.
- (Beam can also be part of a free-standing apparatus, for example like a playground swing or similar.)
- User pulls rope "A" until sliding bracket is close to, or reaches side wall.
- User tilts bed up vertically and leans it against the wall, or hangs it on wall hook.
